Approval of Minutes

Sharon made a motion to approve Minutes from previous meeting. Robert Koniak 2^{nd} . Lesli Abstained (she was not present at last board meeting) All approved. Motion passed.

President Report

Special meeting regarding our projects was well attended and all the items put out for vote passed. 351 homeowners voted.

One of the first projects will be the tennis courts and pickle ball court. Payment plan discussion ensued.

Alan Schantz motioned to the following:

- 1. The standard payment plan for annual dues is full payment billed in December and due by January 1st of each fiscal year.
- 2. An optional installment plan for dues payment will be offered to members under the following terms and conditions:
 - a) Twelve equal monthly payments, due on the first day of each month, beginning with January of each fiscal year.
 - b) A monthly convenience fee of \$7.50 shall be added to each payment.
 - c) Enrollment in the installment plan requires payments via a preregistered credit card or direct debit account with the Association office. Payments to be automatically processed each month without further notification to the enrolled member.
 - d) Upon the rejection of any monthly payment by the credit card issuer or bank the entire unpaid balance of the annual dues shall be due immediately.

David Feller 2nd motion. All in favor. No opposed. Motion passed.

Julian Price Motioned to have the Assessment Fee schedule as follows:

- 3. The standard payment plan for the annual \$450 assessment is full payment billed in June and due by July 1st of each of ten (10) consecutive assessment years, beginning in July, 2019.
- 4. An optional installment plan for assessment payments will be offered to members under the following terms and conditions:
 - a) Twelve equal monthly payments, due on the first day of each month, beginning with July, 2019.
 - b) A monthly convenience fee of \$7.50 shall be added to each payment.
 - c) Enrollment in the installment plan requires payments via a preregistered credit card or direct debit account with the Association office. Payments to be automatically processed each month without further notification to the enrolled member.
 - d) Upon the rejection of any monthly payment by the credit card issuer or bank the entire unpaid balance of the total assessment shall be due immediately.
